The selection gives priority to applicants who are active in the evaluation communities in their home countries. In turn, the presence of evaluators from all over the world enriches the conference experience for all participants, as it contributes to a diversity of perspectives, including on the realities of undertaking evaluations in developing countries.

Eligible candidates are:

- A citizen from a developing country (in receipt of overseas
 development assistance) who lives and works in a developing
 country most of the time (*Applicable for citizens of countries with
 low-income, lower-middle income or upper-middle income
 economies according to the classification of GDP per capita of the
 World Bank. Some bursary sponsors have specific requirements,
 which EES will reflect in the selection process.)
- Involved in evaluation in their home country (*Proof of this needs to be provided in the application form.)
- Priority will be given to candidates working on issues related to the environment, climate change, and other topics that are relevant to GFF's mandate.

Applications will go through a strict review process during which additional information may be asked from the applicants.

Please note the EES bursary support can only be received once by each individual: individuals who received bursary support for previous conferences are not eligible.
