EES is pleased to announce a Bursary Programme for YEE for the forthcoming Online Conference and Professional Development Workshops for 6-10 September 2021. The bursary programme aims to contribute to building evaluation capacity among YEE in developing countries. The selection gives priority to applicants who are active in the evaluation communities in their home countries. In turn, the presence of evaluators from all over the world enriches the conference experience for all participants, as it contributes to a diversity of perspectives, including on the realities of undertaking evaluations in developing countries.

Eligible candidates are:

- A Young and Emerging Evaluator (definition here: <https://evalyouth.org/index.php/mission-strategy/>) who does NOT work for an international institution/NGO, a government, or a university (students may apply).
- A citizen from a developing country (in receipt of overseas development assistance) who lives and works in a low or middle income* country most of the time (*according to the [classification of GDP](#) per capita of the World Bank.)
- Involved in evaluation in their home country (*Proof of this needs to be provided in the application form.)
- Priority will be given to candidates presenting at the conference, YEEs active in EvalYouth, Eval4Action campaign and VOPEs.

Applications will go through a strict review process during which additional information may be asked from the applicants.

Please note the EES bursary support can only be received once by each individual: individuals who received bursary support for previous conferences are not eligible.
