



## **Call for Applications**

### **Support to EvalYouth Regional and National Chapters for Projects to Promote Young and Emerging Evaluators and Innovation**

#### **1. Introduction**

[EvalYouth](#) is a global, multi-stakeholder partnership/network that supports and promotes young and emerging evaluators (YEEs), which was launched in November 2015 in Kathmandu, Nepal during the Second Global Evaluation Forum. The overarching goals of EvalYouth are:

- a. To promote Young and Emerging Evaluators (YEEs), including young women, to become competent, experienced, and well-networked professionals who contribute to evaluation capacity at national, regional, and international levels; and
- b. To promote the inclusion of Youth and Young People (YYP), including young women, in evaluations conducted at the national, regional, and international levels.

EvalYouth currently has four task forces and seven regional and more than 20 national chapters across the globe. The task forces work directly under the leadership of the EvalYouth Executive Committee (ExCom) and Management Group (EYMG).

#### **2. Objectives and Priorities**

EvalYouth Global Network has received funding from UNFPA Evaluation Office to support and promote YEEs globally and in the regions and to promote innovative projects to promote YEEs participation.

EvalYouth is launching this call to seek applications from EY's regional and national chapters in two categories:

- 1) Support for regional and national chapters work. EvalYouth will fund projects that focus on:
  - a. Enhancing YEE capacities;
  - b. Strengthen EvalYouth reach (as a network globally and in the regions) among youth and YEEs;
  - c. Assessing problems and challenges of YEEs;
  - d. Promoting and enhancing YEE networking; and
  - e. Enhance EvalYouth regional and national chapters work.



- 2) For innovative projects. EvalYouth will fund projects that focus on:
  - a. Developing creative solutions to YEE problems/challenges identified through assessments conducted by EvalYouth Global and/or regional chapters;
  - b. Conducting innovative projects in partnership with other EY chapters and organizations; and
  - c. Projects related to creative evaluation approaches.

### **3. Criteria**

- a. The call is only open for EvalYouth chapters (national and regional).
- b. Only completed applications will be considered.
- c. A maximum of \$US 1,000 will be funded to accepted projects with a single project maximum per region OR a maximum of \$US 2,000 when the proposed project is submitted by two chapters - national or regional

### **4. Time Frame of Implementation**

The projects/activities should be implemented by November 30, 2021.

### **5. Application Submission and Deadline**

Please submit your project proposals via the application form no later than October 27, 2021, at midnight GMT.
